

Standard for Programming State Owned County Radios with County Talkgroups

Required Outcome(s):

Every radio that is owned by a state entity and is permanently assigned to a specific county will have that county talkgroup programmed into it.

Standard:

As determined by the Arkansas Interoperable Communications Executive Committee, all state entity owned radios that are permanently assigned to a county should have the county talkgroups programmed into the radios.

Controls and Measures:

1. AWIN Operations will verify that the radio will be permanently assigned to the county.
 - a. Only those radios owned by a State Agency and permanently assigned to a county will be affected.
 - b. Inter-county talkgroup access for non-state entities require the standard written approval from the owner of the talkgroup.
2. AWIN Operations will identify which county talkgroup is required.
 - a. No state owned radio will receive the county Sheriff's talkgroup without the written approval of the Sheriff's office.
3. AWIN Operations will provide the appropriate County talkgroup to the radio shop that is programming the radio.
4. The County entity will verify that the talkgroup is in the radio and is operational.
